Q#1-Besides the forms attached to the RFP, and the certificate of insurance, are there any other forms that are required for this RFP?

A#1-There are no other required forms to be submitted in your Proposals.

Q#2-Does this RFP require installation or configuration?

A#2- No this RFP is for Equipment and Licenses Only as specified in the RFP. Alternate equipment is acceptable so long as it is equivalent to the equipment requested.

Q#3- Will you accept alternate equipment for this RFP?

A#3- Alternate equipment is acceptable so long as it is equivalent to the equipment requested.

Q#4-Where will the outdoor WAPS be mounted? Is there a map that shows the expected coverage of the Outdoor APs? Depending on coverage need, a different AP model will need to be considered as well as mounting brackets.

A#4- No this RFP is for Equipment and Licenses Only as specified in the RFP. Alternate equipment is acceptable so long as it is equivalent to the equipment requested.

Q#5-Are the indoor AP's going into a new construction or replacing existing WAPs. Is there a way to get a map of where all existing indoor WAP's are at each school site?
