


#### **Year Long iMSSA 3-8 District Averages**




#### **Juniors NWEA/MAPS SAT Indicator Results**

## CRT, SEL, & Library Books




- APS does not and will not teach CRT.
  - Still using "old" social studies standards
  - Local control of curriculum
- •APS does teach Social-Emotional Learning
  - SEL is NOT sex education or alternative lifestyle indoctrination
  - SEL helps students
    - Avoid suicide/self-harm/violence
    - Deal with trauma, loss, grief, etc.
    - Thrive and succeed

### Academy Del Sol

- TO PUBLIC SCHOOL NO.
- •NEED for ADS-type accommodations has outgrown ADS capacity
- •ADS still exists and will continue to exist for at-risk students who need extra extraordinary support and flexibility to be successful and graduate
- •Alt high schools first established as separate high schools, requiring entirely separate faculty, staff, and administration
- •Enrollment limited to students experiencing life issues that prevented them from attending a regular high school
- •ADS students did not have access to:
  - Special education services
  - Career/technical education (CTE)
  - Physical education
  - Music, art, and other electives
  - Athletics, or Extracurricular activities

### Academy Del Sol



- •Unexpected move of ADS students to AHS campus due to gas line leak
- •Students, teachers, and staff moved to separate wing of AHS
- •Leak eventually repaired, no need to move students back and further disrupt their progress
- •No ADS student was involuntarily placed into the "regular" AHS student population
- •Many chose to take CTE and other elective courses previously unavailable to them
- •Now, ADS students have
  - Access to the full range of AHS course offerings
  - Access to Special Education & other services
  - Class and schedule accommodations
  - Dedicated counselors, administrators, and teachers

- •Has access to needed supports, such as
  - SPED/504 Services & Accommodations
  - Academic, College, and Career Advisory
  - Mental & Physical Health Services
  - Student Nutrition Services, etc.
- •Has access to full range of available extracurricular activities, with the understanding that some options are mutually-exclusive due to scheduling or teacher availability.
- •Achieves the *COMMON MILESTONE* of high school graduation, prepared for post-secondary education or direct-entry into the workforce
