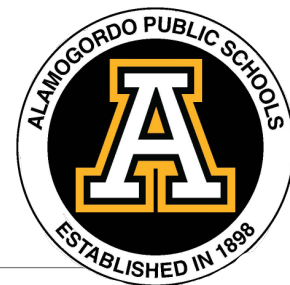

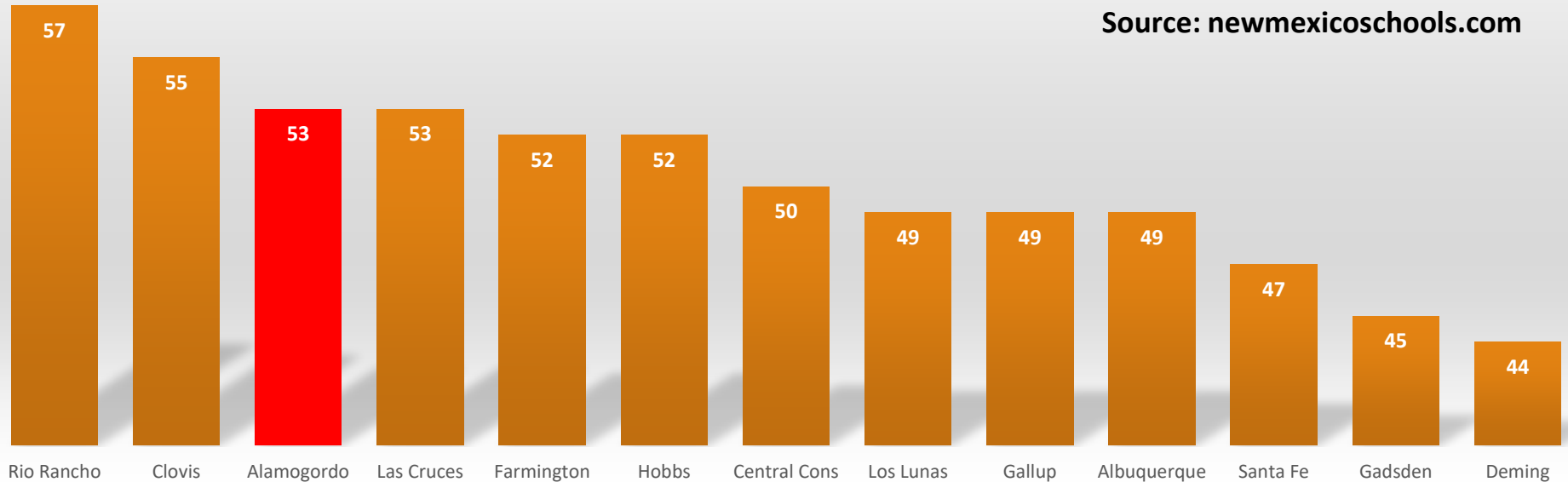

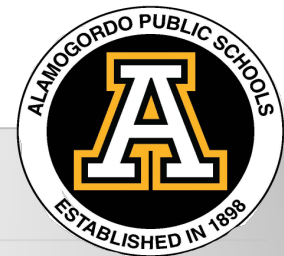


NM Large High Schools Overall Performance AY 2018-19

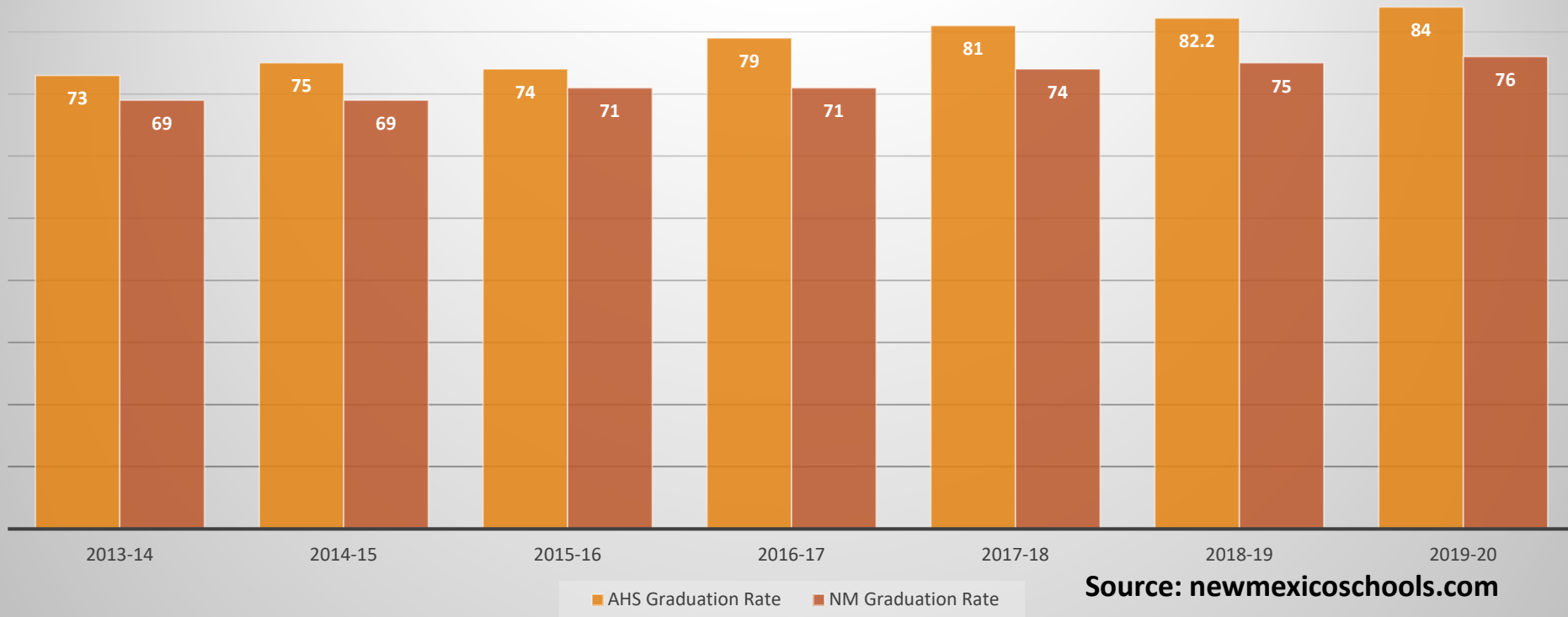

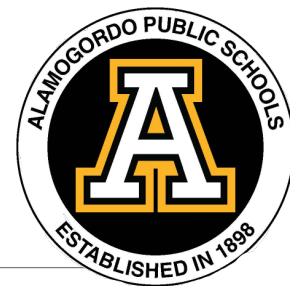


AHS/NM Graduation Rates

iMSSA 3rd-5th BOY-->MOY

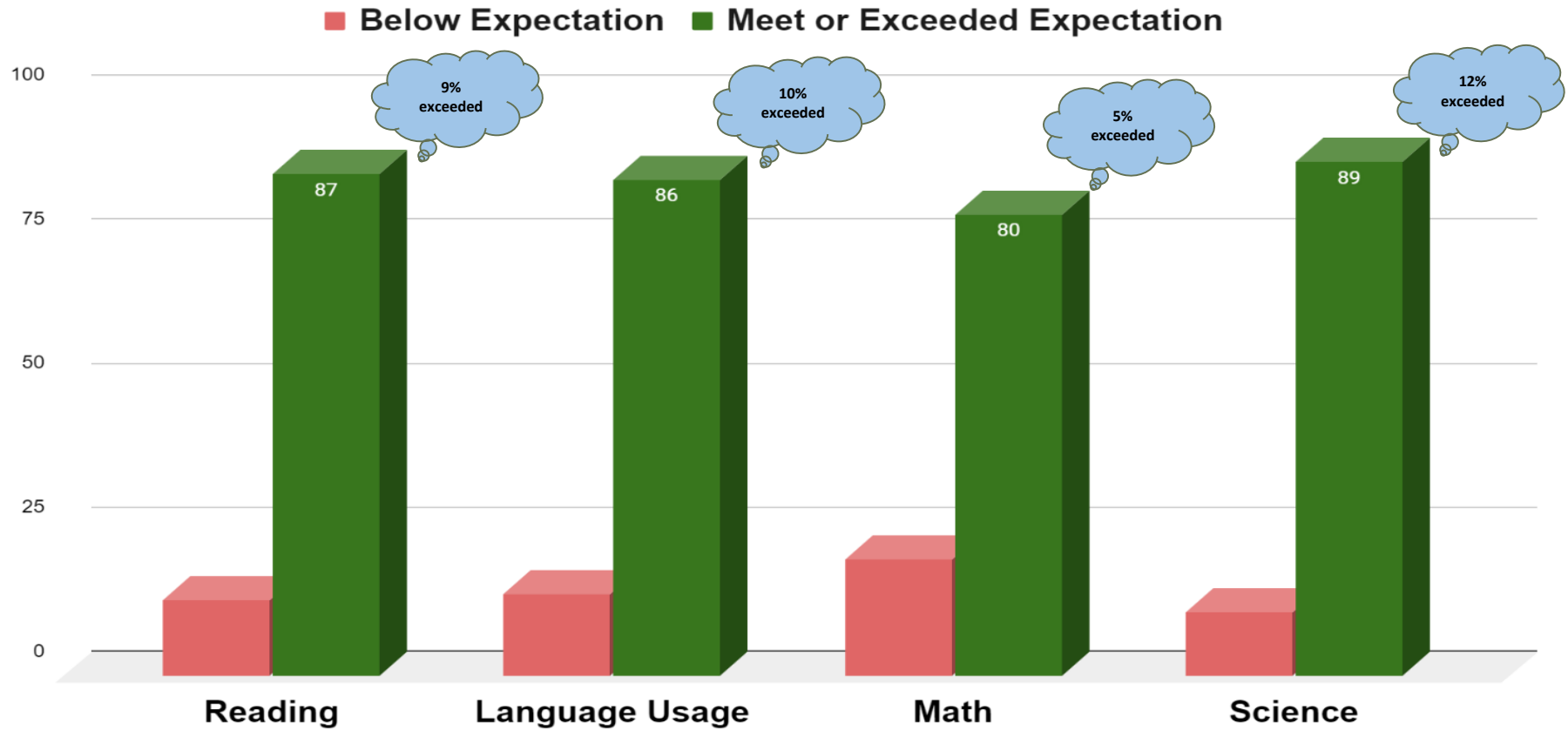

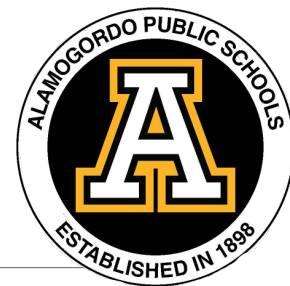

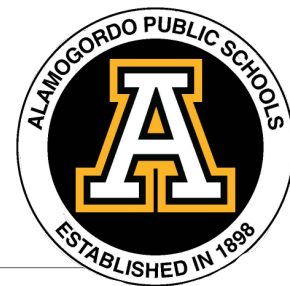
